




2013 Global SPP Review



2017 Global SPP Review












Sustainability aspects addressed by SPP policies

22% do not specify targets






Categories of products prioritized by SPP policies

Barriers to SPP




33%	Perception that sustainable products and/or services are more expensive	
33%	Lack of expertise on SP implementation	
30%	Lack of policy commitments/goals/action plans	
28%	Lack of strong political and organizational leadership on SP	
28%	Lack of mandatory SP rules/legislation	
26%	Lack of sustainable products and/or services to purchase	
25%	Insufficient monitoring, evaluation and/or enforcement of SP policies	
22%	Competing procurement policies	
22%	Competing procurement priorities
